

Corpus Christi College was founded in 1352, which makes it the 6^{th} oldest College in Cambridge and it is also the 2^{nd} smallest. It was established by the townspeople of Cambridge; Corpus Christi retains the distinction of being the only Oxbridge college that was not founded by royalty, nobility, or the Church.

The College is located right in the heart of Cambridge and its location allows easy exploration of Cambridge by foot as all main sightseeing sites are in close proximity.






Conference Space



To book bedrooms please speak to the Sales and Events Manager who can advise on availability, pricing and group bookings.






Sustainability

General Information

Parking: Due to the central location there is no parking at the College. The closest public parking is in the Grand Arcade, which is a 5 minute walk away.

Entrance: The main entrance to the College is on Trumpington Street. Please announce yourself to the Porters' Lodge on arrival. The Porter can check you in and provide directions.

Internet: Wi-Fi is free of charge and available throughout the main College site.

College lawns: Please do not step on the New Court lawn, as with Cambridge tradition, only Fellows are allowed to walk on the lawns within many colleges.

Smoking: Smoking is only permitted by the Golden Gate in Stable Yard, please use the cigarette bin provided. All other areas within the College are nonsmoking, including bedrooms. Vaping is subject to the same restrictions.
